2018 FELLOWSHIP PROGRAM

About

The Indiana Latino Institute Fellowship Program is designed to immerse exceptional emerging Latino leaders in their specific professional field. Selected participate in an education program consisting of preprofessional practice at an assigned site, discussions with community leaders, trips to organizations to learn about the private and public sectors, and an opportunity to receive professional development.

As part of this education program, fellows will have extraordinary access to a myriad of professionals from a variety of industries, who generously give of their time as guest speakers and mentors. Fellows will meet with leaders in Indiana who will engage them in meaningful dialogue about important issues—to the Latino community and our nation.

Purpose

The purpose of the ILI Fellowship Program is to provide gifted and highly motivated Latino students first-hand experience in their specific professional field—STEM, education, business, health, law, non-profit, government, etc. In addition to working for powerful organizations, fellows will have opportunities to build their professional skills, gain knowledge about the local community, and interact with local Latino leaders.

Fellowship Eligibility Requirements

- Cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above
- College senior or graduate student status in fall 2018 between age 20-26
- Must be a U.S. Citizen, Permanent Resident, or DACA (must be current at time of placement)
- Must have reliable transportation
- Must participate in mandatory training: TBD

Fellow Selection Process

Fellowship applicants must submit the following documents:

- Fellowship application
- Two letters of recommendation
- Resume or Curriculum Vitae
- School Transcript

Applicants must display evidence of leadership skills and potential for further growth, a demonstrated commitment to their field of study, and initiative. These qualities, along with the strength of the application materials will be considered in the selection process. The fellowship site may request an interview prior to final placement. **Applications will be accepted between January 1 and March 31, 2018.**

Fellow Expectations

Fellows are expected to complete **300 hours** between **May 2018 until August 2018**. This includes working at the fellowship site Monday through Thursday, and participating in ILI's Professional Development workshops on Fridays. These mandatory Friday workshops will run from 10:00 AM – 3:00 PM.

- Gain 300 hours of experience in field of study

- Trainings to develop professional and leadership skills and increase understanding of community and civic engagement opportunities
- Direct payment of \$3,300 by site
