Quick Guide

DO NOT BE AFRAID TO ASK ANYTHING

Not sure about deadlines or eligibility? Don't be afraid to email or call the organization about it.

ORGANIZE YOUR APPLICATIONS

Keep everything relevant to scholarships in a single file or place for convenience. You will often use the same information for various applications.

DO NOT LET REJECTION BRING YOU DOWN

Getting rejection letters is difficult to hear. Do not take it personal as it means nothing to your competence. Due to high scholarship applicants, committees will not even look at half of them.

CONTACT YOUR RECOMMENDERS EARLY

Asking your recommenders ahead of time is not only respectful, but also ensure you will get a quality letter instead of a regular one.

FOR UNDOCUMENTED STUDENTS

Again, not sure of eligibility? Emailing them will for clarity is important, and they cannot use information against you. If you feel unsure or need more support, connect with one of our specialists to advocate for you.

Scholarship money adds up quick, so apply for small scholarships even if it seems frustrating.

- ✔ Must be Hispanic/Latino
- ✔ Provide proof of conversational proficiency in English and Spanish (Language Proficiency Assessments – LPA's are part of the enrollment process)
- ✔ Be able to attend all hours of the course
- ✔ Authorization to work in the United States
- ✔ Be between 18-40 years old
- ✔ Must be an Indiana resident
- ✔ Must have completed high school

Deadline: MAY 31ST, 2026

Amount: \$1,000- \$5,000

- ✔ Demonstrate financial need

- ✔ Be currently enrolled in high school or home school program and graduating in the spring of 2026
- ✔ Must have a minimum unweighted 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale or 7.5 on a 10.0 scale
- ✔ Must enroll at an accredited higher education institution in 2026-2027
- ✔ If selected, attendance to the virtual awards ceremony is mandatory

LEAP (Legal Elite Athlete Program) Scholarship

Deadline: NOV 4, 2026

- ✔ Be 18 years old or the age of majority in their state of residence (whichever is greater)
- ✔ Be interested in pursuing a legal degree on a part-time or full-time basis in the U.S. to practice in the U.S. following law school
- ✔ Have completed at least two years of undergraduate study at an accredited U.S. college or university
- ✔ Have a minimum of a 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale
- ✔ Have participated in at least two years in a competitive intercollegiate athletic program offered by an accredited college or university
- ✔ Plan to enroll in an LSAT prep course or apply to an ABA-accredited law school within one year of finishing the scholarship program

- ✔ DACA or Undocumented are eligible to apply
- ✔ Applicants must demonstrate a verifiable need for financial support
- ✔ Consistent, active participation in public/ or community service activities

- ✔ Must be enrolled or enroll no later than the fall of 2030 in an accredited Post-secondary institution of higher learning (college, university, or trade school).
- ✔ 250 word or less essay following given prompt

Opportunity Scholarship

Deadline: OPENS NOVEMBER 1ST

Amount: UP TO \$100,000

Requirements:

DACA ELEGIBLE

- ✔ Live in and have graduated from a high school in a targeted locked-out state by the end of the 2023-2024 academic year;
- ✔ Have significant unmet financial needs.
- ✔ Graduated or will graduate with a high school GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale or have a cumulative college GPA of 2.5 or better.
- ✔ Intend to relocate to and enroll full-time in a bachelor's degree program at an Opportunity Partner College in the Fall term of the 2025-2026 academic year

Ed Bradley Scholarship

Deadline: NOVEMBER 14, 2025

Amount: \$10,000

RADIO/TELEVISION/DIGITAL JOURNALISM CAREERS

- ✔ Must be officially enrolled, full-time sophomores, juniors or seniors in good standing
- ✔ If selected, must attend the RTDNA conference free of charge with travel support

Foreclosure Scholarship

Amount: \$4,000- \$1,000

Requirements:

ALL CAREERS

ALL STUDENTS

- ✔ Must be a legal resident of the U.S.
- ✔ Must be 13 years of age or older at the time of application
- ✔ Currently enrolled in a U.S. accredited, post-secondary institution of higher learning (college, university, or trade school)
- ✔ Essay minimum of 800 words- maximum of 2000
- ✔ Must have title page for essay
- ✔ Essay has to be in English
- ✔ No AI generated essay submission partial or entirely will be accepted
- ✔ Essay must be submitted as a word document or as a PDF document

Science Ambassador Scholarship

Deadline: DECEMBER 15, 2025

Amount: \$20,000

Requirements:

STEM MAJORS

ALL STUDENTS

- ✔ Must be a high school senior or an undergraduate student
- ✔ Film a three-minute educational video of yourself explaining a STEM topic you're passionate about. Must be a mini-lecture, not a personal statement.
- ✔ Video must be three minutes or less in length
- ✔ Encouraged to cite the sources used to research your topic
- ✔ Must upload video to YouTube and mark it public.

The NRA Civil Rights Defense Fund- Youth Essay Contest

- ✔ Be a legal resident of the U.S.
- ✔ Between 16 and 26 years of age
- ✔ On track to apply for or currently enrolled in an accredited post-high school/ post-secondary program
- ✔ Submit a 20 second- 2 minute video or a 250-500 word essay

- ✔ Must be a student entering their first year of undergraduate study (including high school seniors) through graduate student
- ✔ Studying full-time (exceptions made for reentry/nontraditional students)
- ✔ Studying at an ABET-accredited program in engineering, technology, or computing in the upcoming academic year
- ✔ Provide one reference
- ✔ Unofficial transcript of your most recent schooling
- ✔ Have a high school GPA above 3.5 or a University GPA above 3.0

Hispanic Scholarship Fund

Deadline: FEBRUARY 15, 2026

Amount: \$500-\$5,000

ALL STUDENTS

Requirements:

- ✔ Must be of Hispanic heritage
- ✔ U.S. citizen, permanent legal resident, or DACA
- ✔ Minimum of 3.0 GPA on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent) for high school students; minimum of 2.5 GPA on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent) for college and graduate students
- ✔ Plan to enroll full-time in an accredited, public or not-for-profit, four-year university, or graduate school, in the US, for the 2025-2026 academic year
- ✔ Submit the FAFSA or state-based financial aid forms (if applicable)

Requirements:

- ✔ Programs of study must be either directly related to the occupational safety and health field or will be utilized to support the occupational safety and health field. This can include a variety of degrees. If your degree is not directly related to occupational safety and health, you will be asked to clarify how you will be using your degree to support the field of occupational safety and health.

- ✔ Provide a copy of your transcripts or report cards for the past two years
- ✔ Three or more recommendations (including at least one teacher)
- ✔ Any documentation related to your promotion of vegetarianism and veganism in high school and/or community including photographs, newspaper stories, etc.
- ✔ Essay required
- ✔ Must be attending a college in the U.S.
